Our overall record for the 2008 football season was 319 - 248 and no, we didn't play 567 games! Our record is based on Unit Play. We rate our games as Regular Plays, which count as one loss or one win and are based on the normal amount a player would wager on a game. We also put out Triple Plays, which we think are worth up to three times what you normally play on a game and count as three wins or three losses, Five Star Plays, and rarely (about 10 per season) our highest rated play- a Ten Star Play, which we think is worth up to Ten times what you normally play on a game and count as ten wins or ten losses. The single most important thing is sports wagering is to play what you feel comfortable playing, regardless of how anyone rates a game. NEVER let anyone talk you into playing more on a game than you feel comfortable playing, but for our record, a Regular Play is one win or loss, a Triple Play is three wins or losses and a Five Star Play is five wins or losses.
